The TESSIE Honorarium - \$200

Criteria

The applicant:

- has been a high school student who has worked significantly with their EODL member group.
- has shown enthusiasm and devotion to theatre as an integral part of the community.

Patricia Beharriell CM (behind the scenes) and EODL (performance) Scholarships — \$400 Criteria

The applicant:

- is graduating or has graduated from high school.
- has been accepted and registered into a college, university or any dramatic arts and science institute studying live theatre (on stage or behind the scenes), film, TV or internet.
- will provide proof of acceptance to aforementioned post secondary studies.

EODL PROCESS:

- 1. The EODL executive and board of directors will establish the amounts of the scholarships. There is usually one recipient of each award and scholarship.
- 2. The Awards Committee, consisting of the treasurer, finance/foundation chair and past president will distribute invitations and applications to all paid-up group members of EODL usually before the end of April of each calendar year.
- 3. The president will contact at least one of the applicant's references.
- 4. The president will notify the three section chairs of the received applications.
- 5. The three section chairs, together with the president, will determine if the applicant qualifies and will decide who will be the recipient.
- 6. The president will send an e-mail or letter to congratulate the applicant and provide them with the details on when and how the recipient will receive their remuneration. This usually happens during the One Act Festival in November.
- 7. The Awards Chair will create a certificate to be presented to the winning candidate.
- 8. The president will send an e-mail or letter to those applicants who were not chosen.
